The Eagle Board of Review Process

The North Star District has developed this **Optional** Eagle Board of Review paperwork review. If the Troop/Scout chooses to have this review, The Advancement Chairman or a member of the Advancement Team for the North Star District would like to review the following 4 items to verify completed documents, and verbal verification of # 5.

- 1. The Complete Eagle Scout Application*
- 2. The Signature page of the Eagle Scout Project Proposal*
- 3. The Signature page of the completed Eagle Scout Project Report*
- 4. The Life Purpose and Ambition Letter (please sign YOUR letter)
- 5. All reference letters sent out

*This is to ensure completion and all required signatures are present

- 1. The above five items will be verified by the Advancement Chair or his/her representative by on of the following methods:
 - a. Presented in person at the District Roundtable
 - b. Presented via picture through E-mail*
 - c. Presented via text pictures*
 - d. Presented outside Roundtable in person to an Advancement Chairman or a designated member of the Advancement Committee
 - *All information presented through a or b must note who is sending the information (name, unit, and position within the unit), whom they are sending the info for (name and unit number) and have at least one other adult copied (per youth protection guidelines). If this is not followed there will not be a response.
- 2. Upon verification from the District Advancement Chair or designated representative, the unit will contact The Life to Eagle Coordinator to obtain the names of potential Guest Representatives from the District for the Eagle Scout Board of Review.
