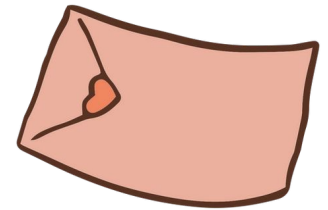

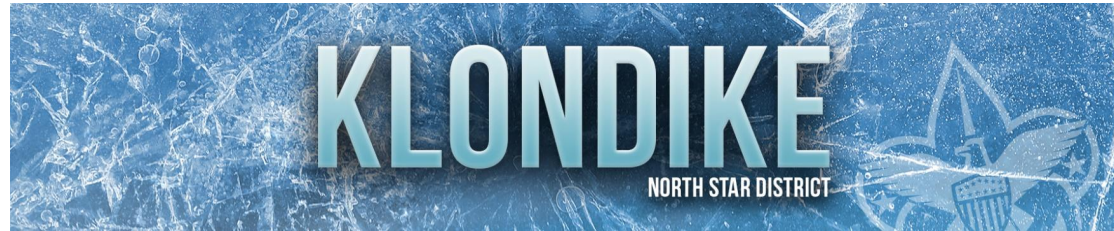

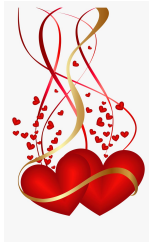

This training is held over two weekends and participants will complete a personal action plan called a "ticket" within 18 months.

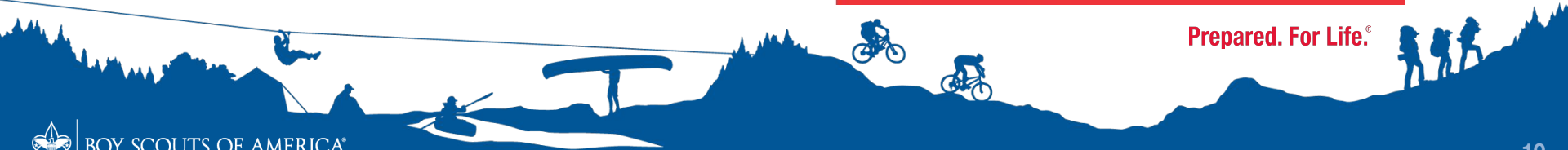

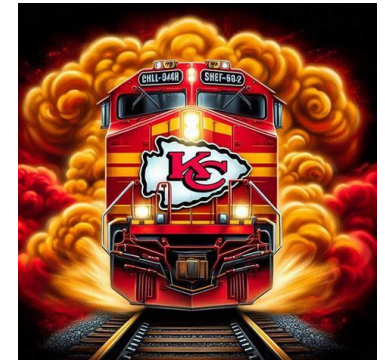

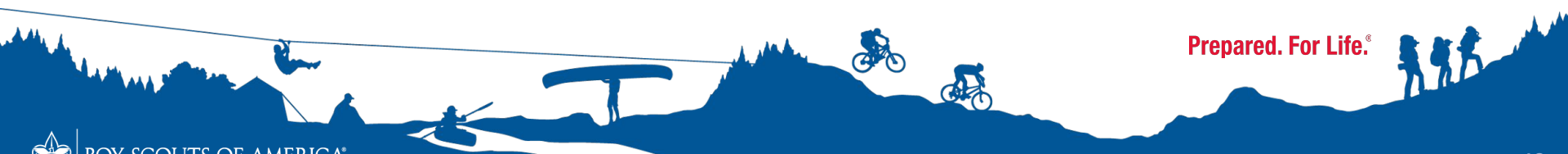
